WGBC International Wine Competition Consolidation Program 2023 is open to all <b><u>certified 100% BC grape wine</u></b> (as certified by BC Wine Authority). <b>NEW:</b> You must provide information to confirm your wine is certified 100% BC grape. This is required for participation and must be added to your packing list (see below).		Certified 100% BC grape wine		
Winery to register and pay for entry to competition. Visit the competition's website (can be linked from Consolidation Schedule) for information regarding entry, number of bottles required and rules. Only competitions listed on the Consolidation Schedule are eligible for WGBC support. If you choose to participate in other competitions, please contact <a href="#">Brad Forcand</a> to request assistance.		Required		
Winery to pre-package wine for international shipment (proper shipping boxes are recommended rather than standard wine cases).		Required		
Winery to label boxes! Name of winery, address, etc. and name of competition clearly showing on <b>outside</b> of box.		Required		
Winery to include/attach any documentation required by the competition, according to its rules.		Required		
You must provide information to confirm your wine is certified 100% BC grape. This is required for participation (To confirm; please choose appellation on packing label spreadsheet)		Required		
Winery to attach Packing List to <b>outside</b> of all boxes (see <a href="#">sample</a> ).		Required		
Winery to number boxes: 1 of 2, 2 of 2, as applicable.		Required		
Winery to email <a href="#">Packing List in EXCEL FORMAT</a> (also referred to as commercial pro forma invoice) to <a href="#">Brad Forcand</a> @ SCHENKER.		Required		
<a href="#">FDA food facility registration number</a> must be on your Packing List for USA competitions. Please ensure your registration is current - if it isn't, you will delay the shipment from crossing into the United States!		Required	N/A	N/A
