The northern latitude of the Shuswap contributed to winter temperatures hitting  $-30^{\circ}\text{C}$  and causing significant bud damage, trunk damage and some vine loss, lowering the crop significantly. Like the other interior regions, after the cold winter, the spring, summer, and fall were very warm resulting in advanced growth throughout the season and an early harvest of fruit with higher brix and ripe flavours.

\* GDD is the measure of heat units available for vine development during the growing season.  
The average is based on a 10 year sample for this region.
