




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The Thompson Valley experienced a similar vintage to the other interior BC wine regions. The Thompson Valley also saw similar issues with cold temperatures in December 2022 that caused bud kill resulting in significant crop loss. Hybrid varieties and buried or geotextile covered vinifera vines fared better, but still showed some damage from the extreme temperatures. The growing season that followed was dry and hot with early flowering, veraison and harvest dates. Fruit quality was good with great structure and acids having maintained surprisingly well given the heat.

\* GDD is the measure of heat units available for vine development during the growing season.  
The average is based on a 10 year sample for this region.
