

Eligibility Criteria for 2024 and 2025 Replacement Wines "Crafted in BC" Wines:

Following requests from BC wineries, Wine Growers British Columbia engaged with international wine and spirit competition partners included in our member-exclusive consolidation program to confirm whether Replacement *Crafted in BC* wines are being accepted for judging. Many competitions have created separate tasting categories to accommodate these wines.

Cascadia Wine Competition

Accepting Replacement "Crafted in BC" wines only if made from 100% grapes grown in the Pacific Northwest (Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Montana, or British Columbia). Please ensure you list the region(s) on the entry form.

Chardonnay Du Monde

Accepting Replacement "Crafted in BC" wines.

Decanter World Wine Awards

Accepting Replacement "Crafted in BC" wines submitted under 'Canada->Multi-region blend' category.

International Wine & Spirits Competition

Accepting Replacement "Crafted in BC" wines submitted under 'Canada->Other' category.

Los Angeles International Wines & Spirits Competition

Accepting Replacement "Crafted in BC" wines. Please note on the entry form or entry notes if the wine is a "Crafted in BC" wine.

Pacific Rim Wine Competition

Accepting Replacement "Crafted in BC" wines.

San Francisco International Wine Competition
